

SOME GUIDELINES for HOSTING SVAA SHOOTS (Updated for 2024)

FEES - Adults \$10

Youth (17 yrs & under) - \$5

SVAA Championship Adults - \$15

Youth - \$10

Those who do not belong to an SVAA affiliated club must shoot as guests and are not eligible for awards or team competition. Guest fees are the same as SVAA member fees (see above)

Archers can shoot any division/style more than once but all additional scores will be as a guest and not eligible for awards, team competition points or Traditional Travelling Trophy competition points. Guests are still charged the same shooting fees.

Shooters can shoot more than one division/style (ie: FS and BHFS) for awards and team points  
Youth CANNOT shoot Pro or Adult divisions.

NO Traditional are offered for youth

SVAA does not offer crossbow styles in any age group

Scorecards MUST be filled out & signed with three signatures. Scorecards MUST have

\*\*Archers name & club

\*\*Division (Pro – Adult – SR – SSR – MSR – Young Adult – Youth – Cub),

\*\*Style ( FS – FSL – FSLR – BB – BBR - Traditional - BHFS) for (18 yrs & older)

Youth Styles (FS – FSLR - BB – BHFS) (for 17 yrs & younger)

No BBR, IBO or traditional styles offered in youth classes

Gender – Male (M) or Female (F) as decided on gender listed on archer's birth certificate

Youth to circle their age group and provide their birthdate when asked to do so

Name and which SVAA affiliated club shooter is a member of.

Address optional since all results are available at their club or on the SVAA website.

Division/Style must be indicated on each archers scorecards before they begin to shoot.

YOUTH (11 yrs & under) shoot at 10 yds

All shooters must straddle the line.

There will be 2 practice ends – then shoot for score. Last two ends (NFAA FITA 450/5 arrows) or last three ends (FITA 600 & 450/3arrows) will be scored the regular way on the front of the card and then will be scored inside out (tie-breaking spot only) on the back of the card. Completed scores must be listed in the proper box in the upper right hand corner of an archers scorecard including the inside outs

Total inside outs will be totaled and entered in the box on the front right hand corner of the scorecards marked I/O.

MAA/SVAA no longer offers MAA 420 round targets. If you have a green scorecard then disregard in the right hand corner of your scorecard that say 6s and 7s. 6s are now spots and 7s will be I/O (inside outs)

There will be no shooting during the halfway break or no practice after the break before continuing to shoot for score.

Bowhunter, Barebow, and Traditional equipment must be inspected before the shooting begins. See the NFAA website for the most up-to-date rules.

Score in groups of three or more with two scorers and one arrow caller. Archers cannot touch arrows, their target or pull arrows until all scoring is done in their group.

Archers may not twirl their arrows nor skydraw their bows.

Clubs receive 63% of total collected shoot entries and 100% of their concessions

Shooters may not have more than two targets except at the discretion of the line judge.

First line shoots the bottom targets – Second line shoots the top targets. At the halfway break archers will switch position of their targets with the second line then shooting first at the bottom targets and the first line shooting second at the top targets.

If more than the prescribed number of arrows are shot at a one spot target than the highest scoring arrow(s) shall be pulled scoring the end. Check MAA for the most up-to-date rulings on scoring

Pre-registration is required – all others must take their chances of finding an opening on the line. Clubs are urged to hold a special line for their own club members when necessary (ie. A Thursday or Friday line)

NO SMOKING is allowed in the archery building when hosting SVAA shoots
