

A lot of changes for 2012.

The shoot results only be available on the SVAA website after the 2012 Shoot Schedule is send out to the mailing list. Only the clubs will receive printed results and all awards will be send to the clubs. Archers may pick up their awards with their respective clubs.

Team competition is changing to 4 categories.

Category I

This Category will consist of all **Male** divisions (Pro – Open – Senior – Master Senior -Youth)
Styles (Freestyle, BowHunter Freestyle & IBO)

A club is allowed only one placing in this Category.

Category II

This Category will consist of all **Female** divisions
(Pro – Open – Senior - Master Senior – Youth)
Styles : Freestyle, BowHunter Freestyle & IBO

A club is allowed only one placing in this Category.

Category III

This Category will consist of all **Male** divisions (Pro – Open – Senior – Master Senior - Youth)
Styles :Freestyle Limited - Bowhunter Freestyle Limited – BareBow (includes Traditional) –
Bowhunter BareBow

A club is allowed only one placing in this Category.

Category IV

This Category will consist of all **Female** divisions (Pro – Open – Senior – Master Senior - Youth)
Styles :Freestyle Limited - Bowhunter Freestyle Limited – BareBow (includes Traditional) –
Bowhunter BareBow

A club is allowed only one placing in this Category.

All Divisions/style/gender is broke down into classes of AA-A-B
(except Pro, Traditional & youth which is broke down by style/gender/age group)

For classes to qualify for team competition points, the class must have completed scores from at least three different archers from at least two different clubs

Archers may shoot in as many different Categories as they wish but only the **first score** shot in any Division/style will count toward individual or team competition. All additional scores shot in same Division/style will be treated as GUEST scores.

The TOTAL amount of club points that can be earned per shoot is 16 points

Points are awarded to each club's best placing in each of the 4 Categories.

1st – 4 points

2nd – 3 points

3rd – 2 points

At any shoot 1 point will be awarded to any club competing but not earning any team competition points for having a team present.

At the end of the season the club with the most Team Competition points wins.

Youth (11 yrs & under) - 10 yds

Seniors (55 yrs & older)

Master Seniors (65 yrs & older)

New scorecards are being made to add these changes. Archers will be given two scorecards as usual – one yellow & one white – the yellow card will be the card that is turned in for score. This enables us to use the old cards until they are gone.

The new scorecards will have the SVAA website printed on the scorecards for easier accessibility
