

Saginaw Valley Archery Association Scholarship

Saginaw Valley Archery Association (SVAA) is dedicated to encourage the growth of young archers in both their archery and education. SVAA will award scholarships on a yearly basis to SVAA member. The scholarship amount will be \$500.00 with the possibility of multiple scholarships awarded.

The winners of scholarship will be notified by April 15 of the current year via a confirmation letter with the award money being sent to the higher education program of their choice. If the award recipient decides not to attend the higher education program then the money will be returned to the SVAA scholarship fund. The award money can be used for tuition, books, schools supplies, computers, software, etc.

CRITERIA

- Applicant must have shot at least three SVAA tournaments in the last year and be an active member of an SVAA affiliated club
- Applicant must be enrolled full-time at a higher education program or accepted for the fall semester
- Applicant must currently hold a minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA
- **Submit your name, address, SVAA affiliated club, three current SVAA shoots attended, current high school or higher education institution, major in the first paragraph of a one page, double spaced, aerial font 12, one inch border pdf document. Also include in the document hobbies, extra-curricular activities, and archery awards, effect of archery on your life and why you are deserving of this award along with an official current transcript.**
